To county superintendents:-

You will receive, in a day or two, copies of our new List of books for school libraries in quantities sufficient for the teachers under your jurisdiction. Please see that these reach the districts at the earliest possible moment. The printer has delayed the pamphlets, and it is so near the end of the year in the rural schools that the lists will be of little value this year unless the teachers may have them at once.

Much time, and considerable of the state's money have been expended in preparing and distributing this list, in the hope of helping the schools of Nebraska to establish school libraries, to select the best books, and to get them for the least money. County superintendents will confer a favor on this Commission, and a benefit upon their schools if they will see that these lists are promptly sent to the teachers, or to directors, as discretion dictates. Since we shall not print a new list for two years, teachers should regard the copies distributed to them as the property of the school districts, and care should be taken to put them where the teachers can find them next fall.
