RULES FOR BORROWERS.

Borrowers.—Any resident of the community who signs the required application card and agreement may draw books.

Issuing Books.—Only one volume may be issued to a borrower at a time, except where books are published in more than one volume, when two may be issued. A book may be kept for two weeks, and may then be renewed for two weeks more.

Fines.—A fine of one cent a day for overdue books may be collected by the librarian, and no books may be lent to any person who has an unpaid fine or a book charged to him. All injuries beyond reasonable wear shall be paid for by the borrower, and the librarian is authorized to collect such fines and transmit the money so collected to the Secretary of the Commission. The fines for overdue books may be used to pay the transportation expense of the library.
